SHOW RULES

- Payment/Entries: All entries must be submitted online via GLOBAL ENTRIES ONLINE (GEO) before the closing date. There are no refunds under any circumstances once entries have closed. No late entries will be accepted and no changes to classes on the day. No emailed entries will be accepted, nor entries paid with cash or cheque. If you require assistance, please email imhrnsw@yahoo.com
- 2. Registration/Ownership: All exhibits must hold CURRENT registrations with a recognised society and be owned or leased by the exhibitor. Pending registrations with another society will not be accepted. A copy of BOTH sides of registrations must be emailed along with a copy of your GEO receipt of entry to imhrnsw@yahoo.com for exhibits not registered with IMHR. Exhibits registered with IMHR (but not current) must have registration brought up to date, including transfers, even if registered with another society. All paperwork must be received before close of entries.
- 3. Show Rules: All show rules applicable to IMHR Inc. and as directed by IMHR Show Management team shall apply to this event. It is a condition of entry that you accept these rules and any amendment made thereto. All other IMHR rules not mentioned in this program apply. Latest handbooks are available for FREE download from the IMHR website, or a printed copy is available to purchase via the IMHR Online Shop. APSB and AMHA rules may apply in addition to IMHR rules.
- 4. Membership: All handlers must be financial member of IMHR Inc. for more than 24 hours preceding the event. It is the responsibility of the entrant to ensure that all handlers of their exhibits are financial members of IMHR. Anyone found breaching this condition shall forfeit all awards and entries and may be subject to further disciplinary action.
- 5. Measuring: Compulsory at this event for all exhibits entered in Saturday's Young Stock Feature Show and to be held between 7.30-8.45am on Saturday 20th July at a location to be advised. Additional measuring times may be available on the Friday afternoon at the organiser's discretion. Measuring for Sunday's Winter Show is by request (prior to 8.45am) or protest only. Exhibits competing as American Shetland and APSB Shetland are exempt from measuring.

- 6. **Protests:** Any protest must be accompanied by a \$50 protest fee which will be returned if the protest is upheld. Protest of rules must be lodged to IMHR Show Management within 10 minutes of class completion. Protest on horse height will be accepted during the height for age halter class only. Once judging has concluded for a Champion award, no protest will be accepted. Horses may be re-measured once only, and that measurement will be deemed final.
- 7. Height For Age: Horses must be entered in their respective classes according to their age at 1st August. All horses must fulfill height for age requirements (based on 1st August age) and MUST show according to height measurement. AMHA exhibits must meet AMHA height for age criteria.
- Substitutions: Substitutions will NOT be accepted.
- Colour Classes: Exhibits can only enter ONE colour class. Judging is based on PHENOTYPE (the way the horse looks) and not GENOTYPE (the genetic colour of the horse). Pintaloosas and horses with multiple patterns and/or colours should enter the Any Other Colour class.
- 10. American Shetland, Miniature/Small Pony,
 APSB Shetland and Stock Type Classes:
 American Shetlands may only enter halter
 classes denoted as American Shetland even if
 dual registered. Miniature/Small Ponies may
 only enter halter classes denoted as
 Miniature/Small Pony even if dual registered.
 APSB Shetland ponies are to be shown as per
 APSB rules (coat not clipped). Stock Type
 exhibits may only enter halter classes denoted
 as Stock Type and may not also enter the open
 halter classes.
- 11. Prizes and Trophies: Class placegetters to 5th place will receive a ribbon. Champion and Reserve Champion will receive a sash. Supreme winners will receive a sash. Supreme of supreme winners will receive a sash and garland.



- 12. Force Majeure: IMHR Inc. shall not be liable for any delay or failure to perform its operations, activities, shows, and events to the extent such delay or failure results from a force majeure to occurrence. A force majeure occurrence is defined as any occurrence arising from causes beyond the reasonable control of IMHR Inc, and which delays or prevents performance by IMHR Inc. otherwise required by this agreement, including but not limited to any (i) breakages or accident to equipment machinery or facilities, (ii) any strikes, lockouts, or other labor difficulties. (iii) statues, ordinances, regulations, orders, or rules issued by governmental authorities. (iv) judicial decrees or orders. (v) acts or god, (vi) animal diseases and/or quarantines; (vii) wars, riots, or insurrections; (viii) civil disobediences, public demonstrations or sabotage: (ix) fires, floods, explosions, or inclement weather: (x) inability to obtain necessary labour, materials, supplies, utilities, or transportation: (xi depressions, recessions, or other economic downturns; (xii) embargoes of energy shortages, or (xiii) other causes beyond IMHR's reasonable control.
- 13. Sponsorship/Advertising: Sponsorship and advertising may be available via the IMHR online shop. Ads must be supplied by advertiser and received by entry closing date. All sponsorship enquiries email: imhrnsw@yahoo.com
- 14. **Catalogue**: In the interests of reducing our carbon footprint, catalogue will be available in digital format only (no catalogue fee will be payable). All information contained in the catalogue will remain confidential until the catalogue is made available to download.
- 15. **Sportsmanship**: Any displays of bad sportsmanship or disrespect including but not invited to leaving the arena before directed by the steward, leaving the arena before placement of ribbons, refusing to accept a placing, disrespectful remarks made to the judge, steward or any other exhibitors or any other conduct deemed as unsportsmanlike by Show Management will result in the exhibitor being disqualified for the remainder of the show including all horses entered by that exhibitor. It may also lead to further disciplinary action by the national committee.

- 16. **Welfare of Exhibits**: Cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment of any horse or pony will not be tolerated and the offender will be barred from the grounds for the duration of the show without refund. The behaviour shall also be reported to IMHR National Committee for further action. Whips are not permitted in any class.
- 17. **Insurance**: IMHR Inc. is insured through affiliation with Equestrian Australia.
- 18. Photography: IMHR may appoint an official photographer for this event. No other professional photographers will be permitted to take photographs in the arena or immediate surrounds without prior permission if a professional has been appointed.
- 19. **Champions**: Champion halter classes are contested between first place getters in the respective section.
- 20. **Judges**: All events will have one judge to be advised when appointed. The judge's decision is final
- Fancy Dress: Must comply with general show rules (e.g. enclosed footwear) and must be pre-entered.
- 22. **Property Identification Code (PIC)**: All NSW exhibitors must supply their PIC when entering via GEO. Details on how to obtain a PIC are on the DPI website. www.dpi.nsw.gov.au
- 23. **Novice Events:** Novice Events are for those who have not won a first place in a similar event at State or National level.
- 24. Youth Events: Exhibits in Youth Events may be Miniature, Small, Little Horse, Stock Type or Miniature/Small/Shetland Pony or American Shetland. No youth may exhibit a colt or stallion (regardless of exhibit age) in Youth events, novelty events or fancy dress.
- 25. Geldings: Exhibits competing in gelding classes must be registered as geldings. Colt/Stallion papers need to be amended to gelding status prior to entries closing.
- 26. Clipping: Clipping of exhibits is optional in all classes at winter events. Judge will be made aware. APSB Shetlands cannot be clipped under any circumstances.
