ENTERING THE SHOW

To reduce costs and administration, exhibitors must submit their entries for the Grand National Show via the Global Entries Online website - <https://globalentriesonline.com.au>.

You may make amendments to your entries including cancellations and additions yourself up to entry closing date.

Please contact Global Entries Online (support@globalentriesonline.com or call 03 86581473) for assistance in using the online system.

Contact IMHR (imhrnationalshow@gmail.com) for enquiries regarding the show.

Please make sure you have met all the pre-requisites including:

- ✓ CURRENT registrations for all horses and ponies
- ✓ CURRENT IMHR membership for all handlers
- ✓ CURRENT IMHR registration for horses and ponies registered IMHR (even if additionally registered with another organisation)
- ✓ CURRENT IMHR registration for classes requiring IMHR registration such as Amateur and SIREs.

Pending registrations with other societies will not be accepted. Penalties apply to anyone found to be breaching these pre-requisites.

All horses and ponies must be entered using their full registered name. If the exhibit is not registered IMHR Inc, a colour copy of the registration papers must be emailed to imhrnationalshow@gmail.com before entry close date and be available for viewing at measuring. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that the correct classes have been entered.

The age of youth and adult exhibitors is determined by actual age as at closing date for entries.

All exhibitors must acknowledge, accept, and familiarise themselves with the IMHR Show Rules, any changes thereto and accept all direction by Show Committee prior to and during the event.

Submitting an entry to the Grand National Show is confirming acceptance of these Conditions of Entry.

VENUE INFORMATION

The IMHR Grand National Show will be run at the Australian Equine and Livestock Events Centre (AELEC) at 503 Goonoo Goonoo Road, Tamworth in the main indoor arena. For more information about the venue, visit www.aelec.com.au and refer to their Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) page: www.aelec.com.au/About-AELEC/FAQ/FAQ.

Exhibitors can arrive on site from 9am Wednesday, 17th April and must depart on or before Monday 22nd April.

There is an ATM, cafeteria (during show times) and coin operated laundry facilities which takes one dollar coins - \$4 per wash/dry. Change for the laundry can be obtained from the AELEC office during business hours only. The IMHR show office does not provide change for the laundry.

Furney's Stockfeed are the local feed supplier – 02 6762 1363.

GOLF CARTS

Golf carts are permitted at AELEC and are available for hire from DTM Tamworth. Please see the DTM website for hire conditions. You must have a valid driver's license to book and operate a cart. There is a limited number of hired golf carts permitted at AELEC.

Private golf carts are permitted but may only be operated by adults with a valid driver's license. Be mindful of exhibitors, horses, and children on pathways. Anyone found to be breaching this rule or is found to be driving any cart in an inappropriate manner will be asked to leave the site and forfeit all monies paid.

DOGS

Dogs must be supervised always be kept under control on leash. Owners of dogs found loose will be asked to leave the complex and forfeit all monies paid. Please ensure you clean up after your dog or they may be banned from the arena area.

Dogs are NOT permitted in the seating area or in the marshalling area of the indoor arena.

STABLES AND CAMPING ON SITE

Bookings will open on Nominate on Wednesday 13th March 2024 at 7.00pm.

Stables, parking, and campsites must be booked directly with the venue and not through IMHR. You can book sites using the via www.nominate.com.au or you can call AELEC staff during business hours on (02) 6767 5658. There is a detailed venue map on the Nominate and AELEC websites showing parking, campsites, and stables so you can choose a camping or parking site near your horses and ponies.

The map also details sites suitable for tents. Ensure you only use areas designated for tents as pegs may damage the underground watering system.

Caravans are permitted and you must pay for a site for the van. Caravans can be hired locally through www.camplify.com.au.

Stable blocks have water and power in each of the stable rows. You are permitted to clip your horses in the stable walkways however, you must remove all hair and place in bins provided. Be mindful of your neighbours when using the walkways and emptying water buckets.

All sites behind the exhibitor gate are allocated must be paid for if you use them. This includes parking for additional cars and floats. Free parking for visitors or additional cars is available in the car park near the main entrance.

Do not park or setup in any site that you have not been allocated at any time for any reason. This creates issues for other exhibitors who have booked and paid for their sites. Anyone using a site that they have not been allocated will need to move. Refusal to do so will result in expulsion from the show and forfeiture of all entries paid.

SPECIAL AWARDS

The following special awards will be made at the Grand National Show. Each of these awards represents a special memory and we are very proud to be able to continue to include them.

Marie Raines Inspirational Trophy

The winner of this award is selected by the Committee based on member feedback and input. Please visit the show office if you would like to nominate someone.

Fonzie Perpetual – National Grand Champion Senior Little Horse Gelding

The winner of this award will also win the Fonzie Perpetual Trophy with thanks to Pam Broadbent.

Aziz Farasha Perpetual – Senior Miniature Horse Liberty

The winner of this National Champion class will also win the Aziz Farasha Perpetual Trophy with thanks to Meambie Miniature Horses.

Judges Choice – Harness Encouragement Award

The winner of this award is determined by the judge and may be any height. This award is not necessarily for the best harness horse overall but to recognise an outstanding effort in the harness classes by an exhibitor. The winner will receive \$100 cash proudly sponsored by Reddiston Park Miniature Horses.

Ultimate Gelding

They say a good stallion makes a great gelding and this award is aimed to recognise that there are a lot of outstanding geldings at the Grand National. The best overall gelding will be crowned Ultimate Gelding and win \$100 cash sponsored by Goulburn Western Wear.

IMHR National Show Perpetual Trophy

Marie Raines Inspirational Award

In Honor of Marie Ann Raines ~ 27 June 1954 - 13 July 2015



In mid-2015 the miniature horse community lost one of its most admired and respected enthusiasts. Marie Raines was one of the founders of Koriana Park – a stud based in Western New South Wales, which pioneered the breeding of little horses, and which continues to be recognised for the quality of its carefully considered breeding program.

For Marie, showing horses was very much a family affair involving her husband Viv and daughter Kylie. However, Marie's notion of 'family' extended far beyond her immediate household. Marie was an exceptionally kind and generous horsewoman, always quick to lend a hand to exhibitors who may have been struggling to manage horses singlehandedly, or to keep a watchful eye on children while mum or dad were in the show ring. Perhaps that's why almost everyone referred to Marie simply as 'mum'.

Marie's calm nature saw horses warm to her very quickly, and a few gentle words were often all it took for her to settle excitable youngstock. She worked tirelessly for the miniature horse community, helping to organise and support shows in her local area, giving all enthusiasts an equal opportunity to have their moment of victory in the show ring. Yet Marie was content to stay out of the limelight herself.

In June 2012, Marie faced her greatest challenge. Diagnosed with melanoma, Marie, Viv and Kylie would regularly make the 1,000 kilometre round-trip from their home in Warren to Sydney to undergo treatment. Anyone who has ever been brushed by cancer will know just how debilitating treatment can be. But Marie never lost hope, never gave up – and never lost her enthusiasm to share a smile, a laugh and warm hugs with those around her.

After three difficult years, on 13 July 2015, Marie's journey came to an end, and she passed away surrounded by her loving family.

While Marie is no longer with us, the memories of her kindness and warmth will always shine brightly.

The Marie Raines Inspirational Award embodies Marie's spirit of generosity, selflessness and true passion for miniature horses. This award acknowledges the IMHR National Show exhibitor who shares those same qualities - helping to make the show more pleasant for those around them, inspiring others to aim for the stars, and always putting the welfare of their horses above all else.

To the winner of the Marie Raines Inspirational Award, we honour you just as we give tribute to the remarkable woman after whom this award is named. You are a true source of inspiration, and we know Marie shares your joy in being selected as this year's recipient.

VOLUNTEERS

Running an event, the size of the Grand National takes a lot of time and effort. Any assistance that you can provide would be very much appreciated. Come visit the show office to let us know your availability.

MARSHALLING

Exhibitors must be present in the marshalling area for their class at least 5 minutes before the end of the previous class. Notification of gear and handler changes must be made to the Gate Steward and if time permits, a maximum 3-minute allowance will be made. All equipment required for gear and handler changes must be brought to the marshalling area. Once the gate has been closed by the gate steward entry will not be permitted into that class.

Appropriate footwear (no thongs or sandals) must be worn in the marshalling area, or you will be asked to leave the area. Failure to follow direction will result in disciplinary action.

Alcohol is not permitted in the marshalling area at any time.

Dogs are not permitted in the marshalling area or in the grandstands at any time.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that they monitor the progress of the classes and are present in time for their classes. They must also ensure that they have enough handlers, gear, and equipment to ensure arrival for classes in a timely manner.

Any horse not listed in the steward sheet for that class will NOT be permitted to enter the ring. Changes in class entries due to heights or substitution must be annotated on the steward's sheet by Show Management or the exhibitor must hold the appropriate authorisation paperwork to present to the steward. If you have changed classes due to height, the gate steward can verify this via the height stamped on the exhibit number.

Ensure you are at the marshalling area in time to resolve any issues.

All effort will be made to accommodate horses and ponies in other concurrent rings; however, this cannot be guaranteed so exhibitors need to be prepared when they make their entries to have handlers/exhibits ready in case of any clashes. There are no refunds for missed classes.

MEASURING

All horses and ponies need to be measured to attend the National Show unless:

- ✓ the horse or pony is 5 years and over (actual age) AND
- ✓ holds an IMHR issued permanent height card (PHC).

More information about Permanent Height Cards is available on the IMHR website. Any horse or pony may be re-measured via a protest or at the request of a National Committee member even if holding an IMHR PHC.

Collect your exhibitor bag from the Show Office (see Show Office Opening Hours) **prior to attending measuring**. You will be advised of the measuring location by the Show Office.

This bag contains your exhibit numbers which will be stamped with the horse or pony's height at the measuring bay. It will also contain your Show Catalogue. Use that publication to confirm your classes and to make notes in, especially if your horse measures into a different class rather than the one entered. It is your responsibility to enter the correct class based on your horse's height which will be written on the back of your exhibit number.

Horses or ponies being used for the Youth National classes or Fancy Dress do not need to be measured for these events but must be measured to enter any other events at the National Show.

Be prepared for measuring:

- ✓ Know your horse or pony's full registered name (not paddock name)
- ✓ Bring enough handlers to hold horses and ponies while your team is being measured
- ✓ Ensure your handlers know your horse or pony's full registered name
- ✓ Understand the IMHR Height For Age rules
- ✓ Know what height your horse or pony needs to be to qualify for the classes you have entered so that you know if you need to move 'up' or 'down' a height class
- ✓ Be ready to be measured when it is your turn by removing all rugs
- ✓ Remember to request a last hair of the mane measurement if entering AMHA classes

Miniature, Small and Little Horses and Miniature and Small Ponies are measured at the highest point of the wither and must meet the IMHR Height For Age to compete.

American Shetlands and APSB Shetland Ponies must not exceed the height requirements for registration with the organisation they are registered with.

SHOW OFFICE OPENING HOURS

The Show Office is located on the concourse of the Indoor Arena just outside the lifts.

Entry INTO the Show Office is **not permitted by exhibitors**. Please wait at the entrance and show office staff will assist you.

Please direct all enquiries to the Show Office during the times shown below:

Wednesday 17th April - 2:30pm to 6pm

Show days – 18th to 21st April – 6:30am to 30 mins after classes finish

Monday 22nd April – closed

The Show Office may also be closed during show breaks including lunch and dinner breaks.

Staff may be working the office in addition to the above hours preparing for days events or doing other show administration, however, to allow for this administration to be completed without distraction please make general show enquiries during the above times only.

Enquiries relating to **stables, campsites, change for laundry machines etc.. must be directed to AELEC staff**, located near the main entrance of the indoor arena during business hours – Monday to Friday.

OFFICIAL PHOTOGRAPHER

IMHR may appoint an official photographer for the Grand National Show. This photographer shall have exclusive rights to all photography at this event including indoor arena and outdoor shoots. Other than local media, no other professional photographers shall be permitted to derive income from photography on site without prior authorisation.

GRAND NATIONAL HI POINT AWARDS

Kerrie Shaw Memorial – Hi Point Breeder

The winner of this award is determined by a combined score of placings totalled by stud prefix. The winner does not need to be a member of IMHR. This award is usually awarded after the Show to allow time to calculate points.

John Bellette Memorial – Hi Point IMHR Exhibitor

The winner of this award is determined by a combined score of placings for all exhibits by exhibitor. Winner must be a financial member of IMHR. This award is usually awarded after the National Show to allow time to calculate points.

Once a Hi Point award has been determined, the decision is final.

HI POINT CALCULATIONS

Calculations for Hi Point Breeder and Hi Point IMHR Exhibitor are calculated as follows:

2 points	1 point
National Champion	National Reserve Champion
National Grand Champion	National Reserve Grand Champion

AMHA, American Shetland, APSB Shetland, 3DE, Amateur, Novice, SIRES, Fancy Dress and Youth events are not included for overall Hi Point Breeder and Exhibitor awards.

For those enrolled in the IMHR National Hi Point program, the Grand National Show is TRIPLE points. See the IMHR website and Online Shop for more information on the IMHR Hi Point program.

You do not need to be enrolled in the National Hi Point program to accrue Hi Points at the Grand National Show for the Grand National Show Hi Point awards.

BUY, SWAP, SELL SOCIAL NIGHTS

Grab your excess horse gear and equipment and join us on Thursday and Friday nights from 6pm in the main arena on the concourse near the Show Office.

Please bring your table, chair and equestrian or related items to swap and sell. You will need to manage your own site as show office staff will not be available to do this for you. Ensure all items are removed at the end of events for that day so that the arena can be closed.

AMERICAN MINIATURE HORSE ASSOCIATION (AMHA)

All American Miniature Horse Association (AMHA) classes will run under the rules of the AMHA (www.amha.org). All other rules specified in this premium relate to open classes only and may not apply to AMHA classes. These classes are open to all exhibitors regardless of mental or physical abilities.

Judge: Senior AMHA Judge, Mr. Wayne Hipsley, Kentucky USA

All horses participating in AMHA classes must be registered AMHA.

Exhibitors must:

- provide a copy of the horse's AMHA registration papers, front and back to imhrnationalshow@gmail.com
- provide a Stallion Verification Report for the testicles for all senior horse stallions aged 3 years old and older
- ensure gelding status is reflected on all registration certificates

IMHR appreciates the continuing support that AMHA provides to their members in Australia. Judge evaluation report forms are available in the show office.



SUBSTITUTIONS AND SCRATCHINGS

Substitutions for a horse or pony that is being scratched from a class (for any reason) during the Grand National Show are permitted upon payment of the office charge per change. There is no entry fee refund for exhibits that are scratched. There is no fee for horses or ponies changing classes due to change in height measurement.

Additional entries and entries on the day are not permitted.

All changes must be made by 6pm the day before the class to allow steward sheets to be updated.

GRAND CHAMPIONS

All first and second place getters in eligible National Champion halter classes must present for the Grand Championship awards unless officially scratched.

To be eligible to win a National Grand Champion you must have entered all qualifying events.

Grand Champion Youth and Youth Harness

The winner of the Grand Champion Youth award is determined by the results of the respective Youth Showmanship, Trail, and Hunter classes. In the event of a tie, the exhibitor with the highest trail score is deemed the winner. Any further tie breaks are determined by the judge.

Grand Champion Harness

The winner of these awards is determined by the result of the Harness Mare, Harness Stallion, and Harness Gelding classes only. No other harness events are included in the Grand Champion. Exhibits must work out for the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion.

Grand Champion Performance

The winner of these awards is determined by the result of the respective Trail and Hunter classes. In the event of a tie, the exhibitor with the highest trail score is deemed the winner. Any further tie breaks are determined by the judge.

Grand Champion Jumper

The winner of these awards is determined by the result of the respective Six Bar, Fault & Out and Show Jumper classes. In the event of a tie, the exhibit with the best Fault & Out result is deemed the winner. Any further tie breaks are determined by the judge.



Make sure you are familiar with the rules regarding exhibitor dress especially for Showmanship/Handler classes.

THREE DAY EVENT (3DE)



The 2024 Grand National is proud to host the return of the National Three Day Event (3DE). This event is a combination of scores from:

- Show Jumper (first round only)
- Obstacle (specific course for 3DE)
- Dressage in Hand

One entry fee covers all three events. Exhibitors may only enter one horse/handler combination.

The official 3DE handbook for exhibitors is available on the IMHR website under the Publications link.

OUR GIFTS TO YOU

Membership

Normally, membership renewed or commencing on or after 1st May will extend until 1st August the following year. The Committee have extended this to include membership renewed or commencing from 1st March. This applies to everyone and not just those attending the Grand National.

Free Gelding Classes

Halter classes specifically for geldings are free and will be automatically calculated on Global Entries Online.

WA Member Incentive

One lucky WA member will be drawn at random and will receive a refund on entries, AELEC stabling and AELEC camping. This only including horses owned or leased by the WA member.

Random Exhibit Number Draws

Throughout the show, there will be random draws of exhibit numbers. The exhibitors linked to those exhibit numbers will win cash or prizes. Prize and cash amounts will be determined closer to show date and may be based on sponsorship or donated prizes.

\$100 Gift Cards
