PLEASE READ THIS PREMIUM COMPLETELY

- ü **28 Jan 18 – Entries and advertising CLOSE.**
Entries received after this date MUST have late fee paid prior to show if accepted.
- ü Ensure you are familiar with the latest IMHR Show & Performance rules.
- ü Measuring is **Tuesday 27th February from 2pm to 7pm for all horses and ponies on site** and from **7am to 8am on Wed-Sun**. No measuring during show times.
- ü NO refunds or credits under any circumstances.
- ü It is YOUR responsibility to get your horse/pony measured and into the ring on time.
- ü The catalogue/admin fees are COMPULSORY.
- ü Special Notes Re AMHA Classes:
 - o Ensure you also record a last hair of the mane measuring for horses entering the AMHA classes.
 - o Stallions 3 years and over entering the AMHA classes must include a current AMHA Stallion Verification Report (even if it has been provided previously).
 - o Copies of both sides of AMHA registration is required for all horses entering AMHA classes.
- ü Include copies of registrations if horse/pony is not registered IMHR otherwise you will be charged \$20 re-processing fee. Colour copies required if horse is not microchipped.
- ü Pending registrations for other societies will NOT be accepted.
- ü Excluding the APSB Shetland classes, all handlers entering the ring MUST be a financial member of IMHR. APSB Shetland exhibitors must sign a waiver if they are not members of IMHR.
- ü You must be able to get all horses/ponies to measuring at the specified times.
- ü NO whips or canes in halter classes – no exceptions.
- ü Check the Show Rules handbook for Amateur eligibility and ensure you are eligible before entering the Amateur classes
- ü If not already on file with IMHR, a certificate of soundness MUST be supplied for all stallions 3 years and over.

About Our Show

The 2018 IMHR IRT National Championship Show will commence on Wednesday 28th February and finish with the last class on Sunday 4th March 2018. Venue: K Ranch Arena, Mt Hunter (Camden) NSW, Australia. Website: www.kranch.com.au.

Entry Procedure

All entries must be made following the official procedure set out by IMHR Inc. Entries must contain the full registered name of the horse or pony, registration number and if not registered with IMHR Inc, a legible colour copy of both sides of registration papers.

Online Show Entries will be available via the following link from 9th January:

Exhibits in the AMHA USA classes must also include a copy of current AMHA papers PLUS a vet certificate for stallions 3 years and over. Gelding status must be reflected on AMHA papers.

If the exhibit is registered IMHR, the IMHR registration must be current with no upgrade or transfers pending even if dual registered with another society.

Pending registration for other societies will NOT be accepted. Current papers must be produced before entry closing date or entries will NOT be accepted.

All payment for entries must be received by the IMHR National Office by the due date unless prior arrangements have been applied for and approved. All cheques/money orders must be made payable to IMHR Inc. Direct deposits and PayPal must include a copy of the receipt. Credit card payments are also available.

You will receive a confirmation via email from the Online Shop. **This is your entry confirmation.** Please check your entry confirmation thoroughly and advise of any errors / omissions. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that you check the entry confirmation and that you have entered the correct classes. There are no refunds or credits for classes that you have entered incorrectly.

Entry Fees

Payment of all entry fees must be received by National Office **no later than 28 January 2018.**

Entries received later than the closing date and prior to catalogue finalisation date will be assessed a late penalty fee per horse. There is no guarantee that entries received after the closing date will be accepted. Entries that are accepted by IMHR Inc. must have late penalty fee paid prior to show date.

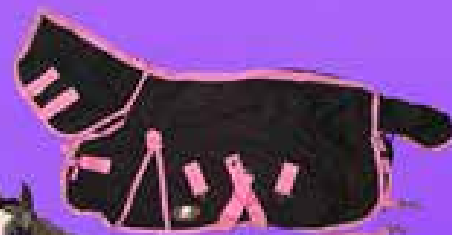

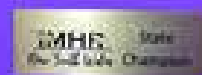

Invalid Payments

Payments returned as unpaid for any reason are regarded as a serious offence and a payment re-processing fee will be assessed for every returned cheque or invalid direct deposit. All debts must be paid including re-processing fees before entries will be confirmed.

Entry Conditions

All exhibitors must acknowledge, accept and familiarise themselves with the IMHR Show Rules, any changes thereto and accept all direction by Show Committee prior to and during the event.

All exhibitors must be current financial members of IMHR and must be the registered owner or lessee of all entered exhibits. No exceptions.

All handlers must be financial members of IMHR. It is the exhibit owner's responsibility to ensure all handlers are eligible to enter the show ring in accordance with this condition.

All exhibits must hold current registrations with IMHR or a recognised Miniature Horse or Pony organisation. ***Exhibits in the Amateur events must hold current registrations with IMHR.***

Exhibits entering the Miniature Pony classes must be registered as Miniature Ponies. Horses may not enter the pony classes and ponies may not enter the horse classes – even if dual registered.

Unless otherwise permitted, American Shetland exhibits are only eligible to enter halter classes denoted as exclusively for American Shetlands. American Shetlands may not enter the Miniature Horse, Small Horse or Little Horse halter classes – even if dual registered.

Miniature and Small Ponies are permitted to show APSB Shetland classes if dual registered and vice versa.

Unless otherwise classes are provided, American Shetlands, Stock Types and Miniature/Small Ponies may enter Miniature/Small/Little Horse performance events based on their equivalent measured height.

WIN a \$100 Fuel Card !

Exhibitors travelling in excess of 500km to attend the IMHR National Show are entitled to enter the draw to win one of five \$100 petrol cards. One entry is permitted for each 500km travelled (return trip from home address to venue) and may be subject to verification.

Please complete the details on the entry form.

Substitutions / Scratchings

Substitutions for a horse or pony that is being scratched from that class during the show are permitted upon payment of the office charge per change.

Exhibitor must already have an exhibit entered in the class and be only substituting the horse or pony. Additional entries are not permitted.

All changes must be made by 6pm the day before the class to allow steward sheets to be updated.

Horses or Ponies for Sale

On the official entry form exhibitors are given the option of identifying horses or ponies exhibiting at the show that are for sale.

A sale fee per horse for sale is payable, and a \$\$ notation will be made in the catalogue next to that exhibits name indicating that the horse or pony is for sale. A list of horses for sale with relevant contact information will be available at the Show Office for potential buyers at no charge. Prices for horses or ponies will be via private negotiation between buyer and seller.

Certificate of Soundness

All Senior Stallions must have a Certificate of Soundness on file with IMHR before being permitted to compete. If horse is not registered IMHR Inc. then copy of Certificate of Soundness must accompany entries.

Stallions showing in AMHA classes aged 3 years and over must include a current AMHA Stallion Verification Report. Please see AMHA section of this Show Premium for more information.

Measuring

All exhibits must be measured by the official measurer(s). It is a condition of entry that you accept the measurement of the official measurer(s). It is the responsibility of the exhibitor that all horses compete in the correct height class as per final measurement.

Official measuring will take place at the venue at the following times:

Tuesday 27 Feb from 2pm à 7pm

Exhibits on site during measuring times must be measured that day.

Wednesday 28 Feb 7am à 8am

Thursday 1 Mar 7am à 8am

Friday 2 Mar 7am à 8am

Saturday 3 Mar 7am à 8am

Sunday 4 Mar 7am à 8am

Measuring must finish by published times to allow any changes to be recorded for the Stewards Sheets. Email imhrnationalshow@gmail.com.

Measuring Process

You may collect your exhibitor pack prior to measuring from the show office in the main arena from **midday Monday**. It will contain your Show Catalogue and Exhibit Numbers plus any additional show information.

Please bring your exhibit numbers with your horse(s) to the measuring bay at the specified time. If your horse or pony is registered IMHR you do NOT need to bring a copy of their papers. If the horse or pony is NOT registered IMHR, please bring a colour copy (or the originals) of the papers with you in case they are required.

All exhibits shall be permitted up to 3 measurements. All horses entered in the AMHA USA classes must have a last hair of the mane measurement recorded. This may be with the current or alternate measurer. The exhibit may not be removed from the measuring bay until officially measured or scratched. No exceptions. Please make sure your horse is ready to be measured prior to entering the measuring bay.

Once measured, your exhibit number will be stamped and the height recorded on the exhibit number plus the IMHR official record. Any horse entering the marshalling area without the official number containing the stamp and measurement will not be permitted to enter the arena.

Measuring Process (cont.)

Replacement numbers are available for a fee if they are lost or damaged.

Please bring sufficient handlers to the measuring bay to assist with rugs to prevent delays. All rugs must be removed for measurement. Please ensure your handlers are familiar with the exhibits name.

There shall be no measuring during show times.

Height for Age

IMHR Constitution specifies that all horses are measured at the highest point of the wither for the open classes. Exhibits showing in the AMHA USA classes must follow the measuring requirements for those classes.

IMHR Events

Horses are measured as per their 1st August age not actual age.

Miniature Horse

- Weanlings must not exceed 30.5"
- Yearlings must not exceed 32.5"
- Two Year Old must not exceed 33.5"
- Mature horses must not exceed 34.5"

Small Horse

- Weanlings must not exceed 34.5"
- Yearlings must not exceed 36.5"
- Two Year Olds must not exceed 37.5"
- Mature horses must not exceed 38.5"

Little Horse

- Weanlings must not exceed 38.5"
- Yearlings must not exceed 40.5"
- Two Year Olds must not exceed 41.5"
- Mature horses must not exceed 42.5"

AMHA USA Events

The show age of a horse is determined from January 1 preceding its birthday.

No Miniature Horse shall exceed 34" in height

- Weanlings must not exceed 30"
- Yearlings must not exceed 32"
- Two Year Olds must not exceed 33"

Sponsorship/Advertising

Sponsorship and advertising opportunities are available for the National Show. All sponsors will receive promotion in the Show Catalogue and on prizes (where applicable).

Full colour advertising is also available. Ads must be A4 portrait and in print ready JPG format and received by entry closing.

Please use the IMHR Online Shop, IMHR Work Order or National Show Entry form for all sponsorship bookings and payments. Please do not email the information without completing booking paperwork.

Exhibitor Bags

All exhibitors will receive an exhibitor bag with their Show Catalogue and exhibit numbers.

We are offering the opportunity for studs and businesses to take advantage of an advertising opportunity by placing promotional material and samples into these bags. You must supply the material to be placed into the bags. Bookings and payment can be done via the Online Shop. Material must be received by entry closing date or inclusion cannot be guaranteed.

Traders

All persons wishing to conduct trade at the IMHR National Show must seek permission from the IMHR Committee and provide contribution to the event by way of sponsorship.

This includes but is not limited to photography services, clipping and grooming services, selling of any goods or services including homemade rugs and equipment.

Trade sites in the main arena attract an additional fee set by the venue. It is a condition that all businesses wishing to have a trade site in the arena carry their own public liability insurance and provide proof of currency. Any person(s) found to be trading at the event without permission of the Committee shall be asked to leave the event and may not be permitted to attend future events.

Please see the National Show Traders Application Form for more information and pricing.

Ribbons and Awards

All National Champion classes shall place from 1st to 10th (excluding prizemoney classes such as SIREs and Sweepstakes). SIREs classes shall be placed to 6th place and Sweepstakes to 5th.

All place-getters shall receive a sash. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion shall receive a sash with rosette. Champion of Champions award winners will receive a sash, embroidered rug, trophy and garland. Supreme award winners will receive a sash and trophy.

Additional prizes may be awarded.

Merchandise

National Show and IMHR logo merchandise may be available for purchase at the show or may be pre-ordered via the Online Shop and collected at the show. Order your merchandise online so you don't miss out and have it posted or collect at the show:

Senior Horse Height Cards

Horses presenting at the measuring bay may be eligible to request a Permanent Height Card via the Online Shop after measuring.

Cards can be issued for horses that are 3 years and over. This card is valid for all IMHR feature shows for the 12 months following the National Show for 3 and 4 year old horses and permanently for 5 year old horses.

Please allow 7 days after the National Show for the measuring information to reach the registrar for verification and processing.

Concurrent Classes – Ring 2

Trail and obstacle events will be set-up in a separate ring in the main arena and will run concurrently with the events in the main arena.

As they are points based events, you are permitted to perform your trail class when it suits your show program, within the published time(s). Please ensure you allow yourself enough time to complete the Ring 2 events before the cut-off time(s).

Show Rules

It is a condition of entry that you understand and comply with all rules applicable to the National Show.

The IMHR National Show is covered by the rules listed in the IMHR Constitution, Show Rules Handbook and the IMHR Performance Handbook plus any additional rules outlined in this publication or as directed by Show Management.

Knowledge of IMHR Show Rules and Regulations, as well as the requirements for each of the classes entered, is the responsibility of the exhibitor.

Copies of the handbooks mentioned may be downloaded from the official IMHR website or members can order a printed copy via the Online Shop or Work Order.

Please take note of the dress code required for the National Show. All shirts must have sleeves or jackets must be worn. Singlet tops, tank tops or similar will not be permitted without a jacket. Exhibitors must ensure that outfits convey a professional image at all times. The outfit must cover shoulders and also from chest to knees. **Handlers not suitably attired will be asked to leave the arena.**

Displays of bad sportsmanship will NOT be tolerated. Exhibitors who disrespect other exhibitors, show management, committee, judges or any other person may, at the committee's discretion, be asked to leave the venue without refund or recourse and may be suspended from entering IMHR shows in future.

All exhibitors must ensure that handlers entering the ring are wearing the correct back number. Anyone not wearing the correct number or failing to wear a number at all will not be permitted into the ring. Classes will not be held up for those with incorrect or missing numbers.

Exhibitors are not permitted to change the colour of any horse (i.e. from bay to black or appaloosa to solid) or to add markings such as socks, face markings.

Swabbing

Drug testing may be carried out at IMHR shows including the National Show. It is a condition of entry that you agree to present your horse for swabbing if directed by Show Management.

Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of all awards and cancellation of any other entries for all horses entered by that exhibitor at the same show.

Further disciplinary action including expulsion may be taken for a positive swab result.

Dogs

Dogs must be under control (on leash) at all times. Owners of dogs found loose may be asked to leave the complex. Please ensure you clean up after your dog or they may be banned from entering the main arena and grandstand areas.

Volunteers

We are always looking for helpers for the National Show. If you can spare some time to assist at the show, please contact us prior to the show or on the day. All assistance is appreciated.

Stock Type Division

IMHR has introduced the Stock Type classes on a trial basis. These events may have increased number of classes and feature at State and regional shows if there is continued support. See the informational poster for more information.

Best Dressed Stables

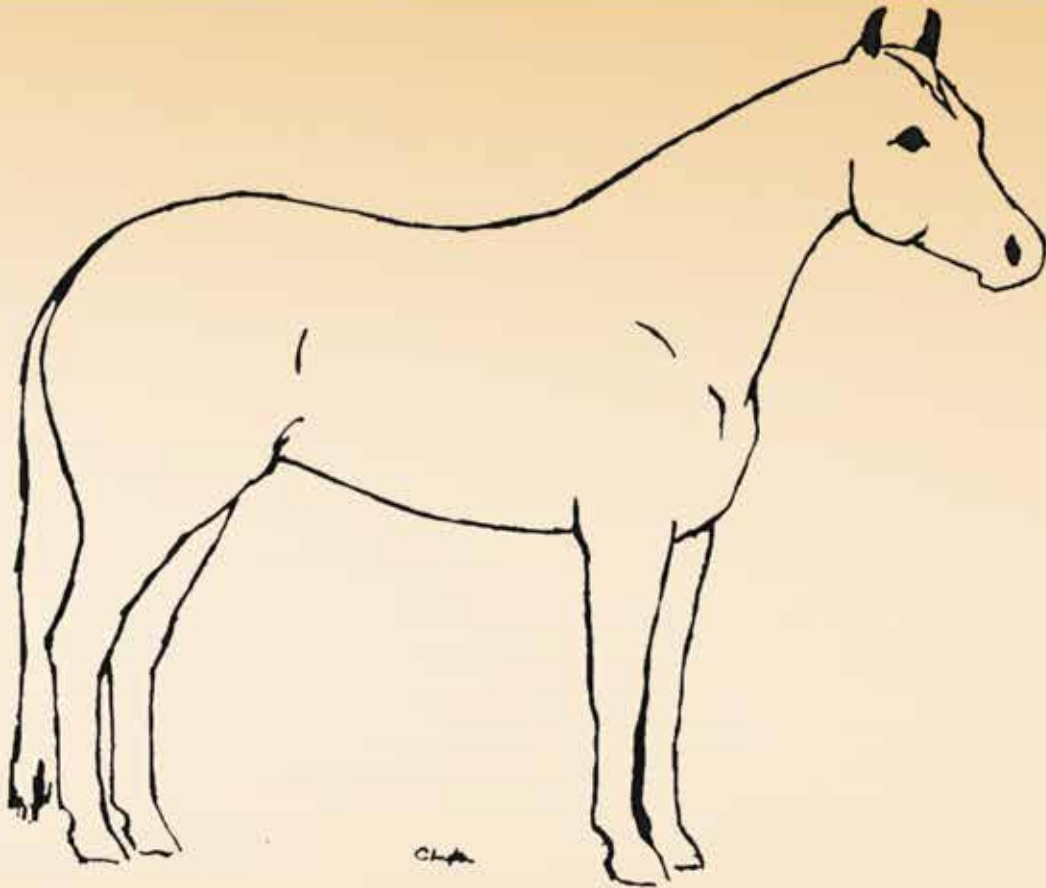
Exhibitors are encouraged to decorate their stables to promote their horses and studs. Please ensure that the decorations do not damage any part of the stable or stable area.

Stock Type Division



Standards and Style

1. Horses showing in Stock Type classes are to be shown in a stock horse manner with the horse standing still, calm and square without over-stretching the neck.
2. Stock type/western show halters are encouraged.
3. Leads may have chains, but chains may only go under chin and not over the nose or in the mouth.
4. Shaving/razoring of heads is discouraged. Clipping is permitted.
5. Pulled, overcut or undercut manes are acceptable.
6. Manes should be natural looking and of moderate length.
7. Tails should be off the ground.

Requirements

1. With the exception of Performance events, horses showing in the Stock Type classes are not permitted to enter the open classes. Similarly, horses entering the open classes may not compete in the Stock Type classes.
2. Current rules for handler's dress will apply.

Smoking

Smoking is NOT permitted in any buildings, stabling or restrooms. Smoking must be done outside and away from the stable area. Please dispose of butts in bins.

Decorations / Signage

Posters, flyers and other printed materials shall not be stapled or attached to any building. Posters may be placed on designated bulletin boards.

Stabling

All bookings must be made via the Online System – www.nominate.com.au.

IMHR Inc. recommends the use of disinfectant in all shared horse areas including the stables and recommends that you bring suitable items for that purpose to assist in protecting the health of your horse.

K Ranch requires that all exhibitors pay a stable deposit that will be refunded when stable is confirmed clean by K Ranch staff.

ALL bedding must be removed (not just manure) and placed into designated areas.

Camping & Parking

All bookings must be made via the Online System – www.nominate.com.au.

Camping in your vehicle or float is permitted, however tents are NOT permitted.

All parking behind the arena is allocated as per map and must be paid for. Please ensure you only park in the area you have been allocated. Free parking outside the front entrance of the arena is available for visitors. Checks will be made to ensure all vehicles are eligible. Anyone found parking or camping without paying the appropriate fee will be asked to leave and may be excluded from further participation in the National Show without refund.

Washing & Clipping Horses

Please be mindful of the water restrictions in place all over Australia and ensure you wash your horses using the minimum amount of water and do not leave hoses running.

Horses must be washed in designated wash bays only. No clipping of horses permitted in wash bays.

Horses may be clipped in stable areas however all hair must be swept up and placed in bins provided. Horses may be presented with heads and bodies clipped. **Eyelashes are not to be removed.**

Class Information

The age of youth & adult exhibitors is determined by actual age as at closing date for entries. For Three Day Event competitors, age is based on actual age at first event of the 3DE competition.

Marshalling

Exhibitors must be present in the marshalling area at least 5 minutes before the end of the previous class. Notification of gear and handler changes must be made to the Gate Steward and if time permits, a maximum 3 minute allowance will be made. All equipment required for gear and handler changes must be brought to the marshalling area.

Appropriate footwear (no thongs or sandals) must be worn in the marshalling area or you will be asked to leave the area. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that they monitor the progress of the classes and are present in time for their classes. They must also ensure that they have sufficient handlers, gear and equipment to ensure arrival for classes in a timely manner.

Any horse not listed in the steward sheet for that class will NOT be permitted to enter the ring. Changes in class entries due to heights or substitution must be annotated on the steward's sheet by Show Management or the exhibitor must hold the appropriate authorisation paperwork to present to the steward. Ensure you are at the marshalling area in time to resolve any issues.

Show Breaks

Exhibitors should note that there will be breaks during the program at the Judge and Stewards discretion.

Breaks will be announced periodically and displayed on the Show Office noticeboard where possible.

Judges

An International judge plus local judge(s) will be utilised during the National Show. Allocation of judges to events will be determined by IMHR based on availability.

AMHA USA Australian Titles



All American Miniature Horse Association (AMHA) classes will run under the rules of the AMHA (www.amha.org). All other rules specified in this premium relate to open classes only and do not apply to AMHA classes.

All horses participating in AMHA classes must be registered AMHA. Exhibitors must send in a copy of the horse's registration papers, front and back and senior stallions 3 years old and older must provide a Stallion Verification Report for the testicles with entry or entry will be rejected.

Champion of Champions

All National Grand Champion halter winners in eligible National classes must parade for the Champion of Champions unless a veterinary certificate is produced.

Failure to parade without certificate may result in all awards for that exhibitor being revoked.

The American Shetland and Small Pony Champion of Champions awards will only be split into Junior and Senior if both are sponsored.

Harness / Long-Reining



For the protection of horses and exhibitors, all harness exhibitors MUST provide a header for all harness events. The header must be 18 years old or over and must remain in the marshalling area and provide immediate assistance if required.

Any harness exhibits that are considered unsafe or unsound by Show Management will be asked to leave the arena.

Whips are required for long-reining and all harness driven classes. Winkers are required for harness driving however, are optional for long-reining classes.

Open to senior horses only - mares, geldings and stallions aged 3 years and over (actual age). Competitors must be aged 13 or over on the first day of the event.

Three Day Event – Triple Ca\$h Bonus – winner of the overall 3DE will win \$150 prizemoney !

The winner will be announced after the conclusion of the final qualifying event.

Ultimate Gelding Of The Year

To be judged after the Little Horse halter classes. Junior and Senior Miniature Horse, Small Horse and Little Horse Grand Champion Geldings are eligible. Stock type Grand Champion geldings are also eligible.

Amateur Grand Champion Geldings, Miniature Ponies, American Shetlands and APSB Shetlands are not eligible.

Prize Money Events

Prize pool is based on entry fee and number of exhibit entering the ring (not catalogued – due to height changes and scratching).

Amounts are determined by the following calculation:

- 1st 40 % prize pool
- 2nd 20 % prize pool
- 3rd 10 % prize pool

SIRES and Sweepstakes are prizemoney events.

\$weepstakes

Open to all exhibits where all sexes are shown together split by height and age. Prizemoney is awarded based on the Prize Money Event calculations.

Guinness World Record

IMHR has been officially approved by the Guinness World Record Board to attempt to beat the Highest Jump by a Miniature Horse record set at the 2015 IMHR National Show by Castrawes Paleface Orion and Rob Barnes with a height of 42.5".

The following conditions apply for anyone wishing to enter this event:

- Horses height not to exceed 38" at wither
- Horse must be registered IMHR
- Horse must be 3 years of age (actual) or over

Safety of horse and handler is paramount. If at any stage, an official determines that the horse is unsound or it would be unsafe to continue, the horse shall be retired from the event.

The event shall run as follows:

- ü Jump will be set at the initial height of 34"
- ü Each horse will be given two attempts at each height
- ü Faulting twice at the same height results in disqualification of that exhibit
- ü Overall winner shall be permitted to make attempts at a higher level.

The final two horses will be filmed as per guidelines set by Guinness World Records to ensure record attempt is captured.

The exhibitor MUST ensure that the official filming the attempt is ready before commencing the attempt to ensure the attempt is fully captured from start to finish. If this does not happen, the record may not be recognised as official.





Special Awards

The winner of this award is determined by a combined score of all placings won by the exhibitor. Winner must be a current financial member of IMHR.

Hi Point AMHA Exhibitor

- Trophy

The winner of these awards is determined based on results in the American Miniature Horse section. This is not part of the AMHA approved program and is provided by IMHR.

Fonzie Perpetual Trophy

The winner of the National Grand Champion Senior Little Horse Gelding will also win the Fonzie Perpetual Trophy with thanks to Pam Broadbent.

Aziz Farasha Perpetual Trophy

Awarded to the winner of the Miniature Horse Senior Liberty. Winner is recorded on perpetual trophy and will also receive a trophy proudly sponsored by Meambie Minis.

IMHR Colour of Money Ca\$h Bonus

If the winner of the Supreme Coloured Exhibit (judged from winners of classes 2.150 – 2.161) is registered ICHR, a bonus \$100 will be paid.
